Listing requirements
Subscription options

Listing of subscription options on OMX Nordic Exchange Stockholm AB

Companies with shares listed on OMX Nordic Exchange Stockholm AB (the exchange) can apply for listing of subscription options on the exchange's list for subscription options.

Distribution of shares

There must be at least 500 shareholders each of whom owns shares worth approximately 10 000 SEK.

Information requirements

The terms for the subscription options must be kept available on the company's website.

Application documents

- Application signed by the Board of Directors or by the CEO of the company as well as an adjusted protocol from the Board Meeting where the issue has been decided upon
- Applicable certificate of registration from the Swedish Companies Registration office or an equivalent foreign registration office
- ISIN code and the applicable name of the instrument set by the NCSD (Nordic Central Securities Depository) (for example IFS TO2B)
- Suggestion of what the trading lot should be (the corresponding underlying value shall be approximately SEK 10 000) the distribution price of the subscription options can have an influence when setting the trading lot.
- Information about desired first and last day of listing
- Terms and other conditions for the subscription options as well as prospectus and, if any, information brochure
- Certificate of distribution of shares which states the number of shareholders who owns at least one trading lot. The Certificate of distribution of shares shall be sent to the exchange no later than one week prior to the first listing day
